



DOMAIN LIFECYCLE

1. Purpose

This policy describes the lifecycle of a domain managed by Utrdba d.o.o., from registration to deletion, including all intermediate states.

Applies to:

- .SI domains
- gTLD (.COM, .NET, .ORG...)
- .EU and other TLD

Individual registries may apply specific rules.

2. Domain lifecycle phases

2.1 Registration (Active)

The domain is:

- successfully registered
- active in DNS
- operational

Duration:

- typically 1–10 years

2.2 Active Period

During this period:

- the domain operates normally



The owner may:

- renew
- transfer
- change data

2.3 Expiration

If not renewed:

- domain enters Expired state

Consequences:

- services may stop (DNS, email)
- parked page may be displayed

3. Grace Period

After expiration:

- domain may still be renewed at regular cost
- services may be limited or disabled

Typical duration:

- .COM/.NET: 5 days
- .SI/.EU: 0 days



4. Redemption Period

If not renewed in grace period:

- domain removed from active zone
- no longer active

Renewal:

- possible with higher fee

Typical duration:

- .COM/.NET: 30 days
- .EU: 40 days
- .SI: 30 days

5. Pending Delete

Final phase:

- domain cannot be restored

Duration:

- approx. 5 days

6. Deletion

Domain:

- deleted from registry
- becomes available



7. Timeline summary

Phase	Renewal	Cost
Active	YES	normal
Grace	YES	normal
Redemption	YES	high
Pending Delete	NO	-
Deleted	NO	new registration

8. Notifications

Provider sends notifications:

- before expiration
- at expiration
- after expiration

User must ensure correct contact data.

8.a Payments and expiration

Renewal depends on timely payment.

If not paid:

- domain expires
- services may stop
- moves to next phases

Provider does not guarantee automatic renewal unless agreed.



8.b Grace period

Grace period may allow renewal without extra cost depending on registry.

Important: Provider cannot guarantee identical grace periods.

8.c Summary

- domain active → while paid
- not paid → expires
- grace may exist
- then → higher cost or deletion

8.d Recommendation

Users are advised:

- to renew on time
- use auto-renewal
- check email

9. Responsibility

Registrant:

- responsible for renewal
- bears consequences of deletion

10. Re-registration

After deletion:



- domain may be registered by anyone

Provider does not guarantee recovery.

11. Limitation of liability

Provider:

- is not responsible for loss
- does not guarantee renewal
- is not liable for damages

12. Policy changes

Provider may modify policy due to:

- registry rules
- legislation
- business reasons
